

Missouri Professional Development System Updates

Reminders

The Missouri Professional Development (MOPD) system includes a training calendar to help professionals find quality local and online trainings, a learning management system that hosts online on-demand-training, and a registry that tracks training completion. Professionals in the system must be linked to an organization so employers have access to data for reports on completed clock hours, CPR/First Aid certification, and Safe Sleep requirements. If your organization is not in MOPD or your staff is not linked to your organization, start now! Find updated courses for clock hours by searching 'DESE OOC' as the training sponsor. The end of the year is coming soon. Please check your completed clock hour training list to see if you are 'In Compliance' for all years listed on your report. To understand your report, please read the instructions for 'INDIVIDUAL REPORTS' of the MOPD User Instructions.

System Down for Maintenance

The MOPD system will be down for maintenance **Friday, November 3 at 11:00 p.m. to Saturday, November 4 at 5:00 a.m.** Users will not be able to log in or access online courses during these hours. If you begin an online course that does not conclude prior to 11:00 p.m., the course may start over from the beginning and the attendance may not save correctly. Please use caution if beginning an online course that does not conclude prior to 11:00 p.m. on November 3.

CPR/First Aid Certification

Reminder- CPR/First Aid (FA) course certification should be uploaded through the [MOPD System](#) education tab to be reflected in system-generated reports. Most CPR/FA models give digital cards to each user and trainers are not able to upload cards for users. MOPD system staff will review the uploaded certification in order to verify official documentation was issued by one of the following approved national models:

- American Academy of Pediatrics PedFACTs
- American Red Cross
- American Heart Association
- American Trauma Event Management
- Emergency Care and Safety Institute
- National Safety Council
- ProTrainings
- Health and Safety Institute (HSI)- includes American Safety and Health Institute, and EMS Safety

CPR/FA must be completed through the MOPD system to receive clock hour credit. Clock hours are issued when the trainer completes attendance.
